

What Does God Want From Me

Let that soak in, let God wrap His loving arms around you, and realize that God loved you when you were a sinner. How could he love you any less as a Christian? *Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.* Once you except there is nothing you can do that will change God’s love for you then knowing what God wants from you will be much easier.
